## 1. INTRODUCTORY REMARKS

In order to provide an objective tool for regular monitoring of the efficiency of Croatia's system for enforcement of intellectual property rights, in the course of year 2008 a methodology for collecting related statistical data was developed. As an integral part of the methodology an extensive statistical report<sup>1</sup> on related data was issued, covering available data up to year 2007.

Following Croatia's commitment to continue monitoring the enforcement of intellectual property rights on regular basis, a further extensive annual statistical report for year 2008 has been issued in the course of year 2009.

In addition to the extensive annual statistical reports, it has been decided (in the course of related negotiations between Croatia and EU in December 2008), that preliminary statistical reports containing rough data will be issued on quarterly basis. This report is the third of such quarterly reports and it covers the third quarter (July to September) of year 2009.

Furthermore, it should be noted that this report is envisaged to contain rough statistical data only, without an extensive analysis which will be available in the annual report. Consequently, the data are presented in related tables only.

The report has been drafted by the State Intellectual Property Office of the Republic of Croatia and is based on data as provided by all stakeholders of the system for the enforcement of the intellectual property rights.
