1. INTRODUCTION

In order to provide an objective tool for regular monitoring of the efficiency of Croatia's system for the enforcement of intellectual property rights, in the course of year 2008 a methodology for collecting related statistical data was developed. As an integral part of the methodology a comprehensive statistical report¹ on related data was issued, covering available data up to the year 2007.

In compliance with the Croatia's commitment to monitor the enforcement of intellectual property rights on regular basis, the other comprehensive annual statistical reports for the years 2008, 2009 and 2010 have been issued so far.

In addition to the comprehensive annual statistical reports, in the course of negotiations between the Republic of Croatia and the EU held in December 2008, it was decided that preliminary statistical reports containing approximate data will be issued on quarterly basis, too.

Furthermore, it has been noted that quarterly reports contain statistical data only, without in-depth analyse, which will be available in the annual report. Consequently, the data have been presented in respective tables only.

The report has been drafted by the State Intellectual Property Office of the Republic of Croatia, based on the data as provided by all stakeholders of the system for the enforcement of the intellectual property rights (Customs Administration, State Inspectorate, Ministry of the Interior, State Attorney's Office and Ministry of Justice).

¹ This report has been issued in three parts, i.e. the basic study issued in May 2008 (*Measurement of the Infringements of Intellectual Property Rights – Study for the Improvement of the Methodologies for Statistical Data Collection*) and two subsequent supplements (issued in July and October 2008 respectively) based on the comments provided by the European Commission (*Measurement of the Infringements of Intellectual Property Rights – Supplements to the Study for the Improvement of the Methodologies for Statistical Data Collection and Measurement of the Infringements of Intellectual Property Rights – Supplements II*)
