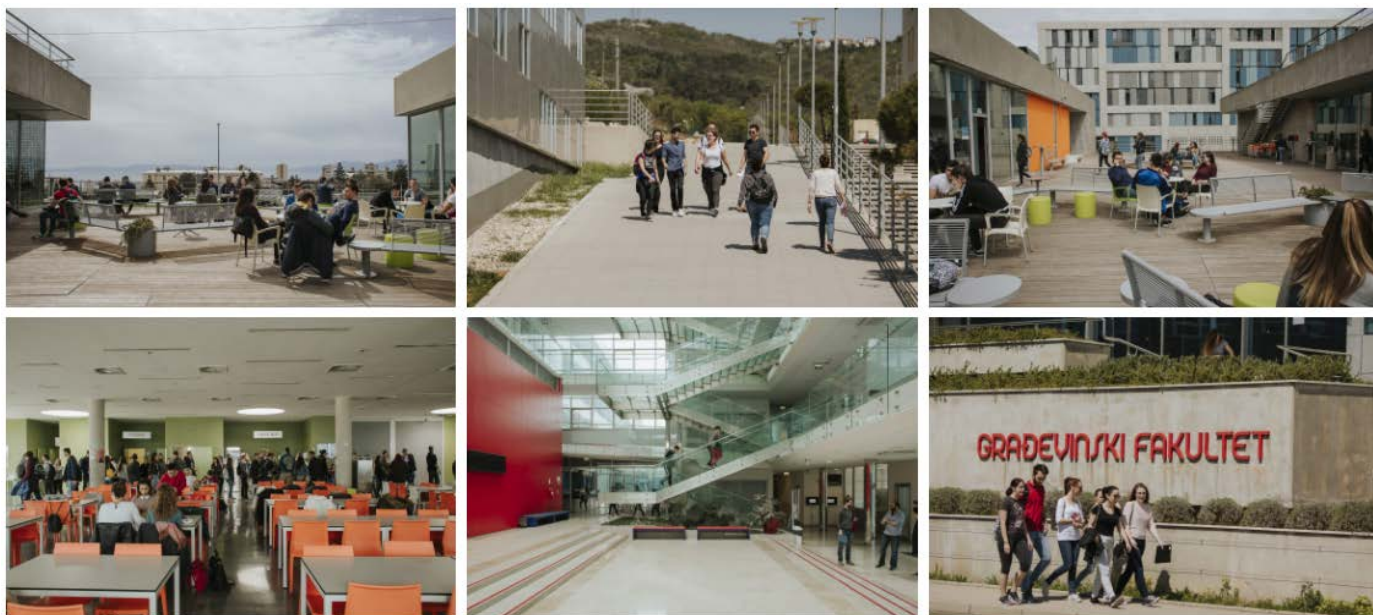

PRACTICAL INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

Arrival to Rijeka

By plane

Rijeka mainly has seasonal flight connections, but the choice of flights in August and September can be quite good, depending on where you are travelling from. If there is no direct flight to Rijeka, another practical option is to fly to Zagreb (ZAG), Venice (VCE), Trieste (TRS), Ljubljana (LJU), or Pula (PUY) and continue to Rijeka by road. All of these airports are relatively close to Rijeka, and the best option depends on your departure destination and available flight connections.

By bus

Rijeka Bus Station does not have a separate official website. Information on bus routes, timetables and tickets is available through [Arriva](#), which operates the station and many of the bus services.

On-site Registration

Participant registration will take place **at the registration desk at the Summer School venue**, immediately before the official programme begins, **on Monday, 31 August, from 3:00 to 3:30 p.m.**

Language

The working language of the WIPO Summer School is English.

Insurance and Medical Examination

All participants will be insured during their stay related to attending the Summer School.

Each participant will be required to present a certificate of medical examination immediately upon arrival.

Currency

The official currency in Croatia is Euro (€).

Accommodation

Accommodation has been pre-booked exclusively for participants who timely indicated their need for accommodation.

Rooms have been reserved at the [Trsat Student Dormitory of the University of Rijeka](#) for the period from 31 August to 11/12 September 2026, at favourable rates. Participants arriving in Rijeka before 31 August are kindly asked to arrange their accommodation for the nights prior to 31 August independently.

Double rooms for single occupancy are available on a first-registered, first-served basis, subject to availability. Once all single-occupancy rooms have been allocated, participants will automatically be assigned a shared double room.

Breakfast is available at the Student Restaurant at a price of EUR 6.00 per meal. Cancellations of the breakfast are possible up to 48 hours prior to arrival.

Payment for campus accommodation and breakfast is to be made in person at the Student Dormitory reception desk. No advance payment is required.

The Student Dormitory reception desk is located on the ground floor of the Campus Restaurant (Address: Radmile Matejčić 5, Rijeka, [Google Maps](#)). It is open 24/7, every day of the week. A receptionist is available from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., while a night security guard is on duty from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. For assistance, contact the reception at +385 51 584 544 or +385 99 469 6296, or email recepcija.trsat@scri.hr.

If needed, participants may complete check-in upon arrival and leave their luggage in the storage room next to the reception until their room is ready.

Likewise, after check-out, participants may leave their luggage in the storage room until their departure.

Parking on the university campus is free of charge but can be busy. Please check the Google Map on page 1 for parking tips.

Meals

Lunch is available daily at the Campus Restaurant, without prior notice.

Coffee and snacks are available on the self-service machines.
